P U R P O S E

Overview

This documentation contains field locations and detailed descriptions of each data field for the two different record segments on the yearly Hate Crime master file. In addition, an overview of how the file data are organized is provided. This should provide an understanding of the data so that it can be processed correctly.

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1. OVERVIEW OF RECORD SEGMENTS

A UCR originating agency identifier (ORI) Batch Header record, identified as Hate Crime Record Type of "BH," is always the first record for a particular UCR ORI. This record is significant in that it identifies the start of a new UCR ORI and also contains descriptive information about the ORI.

Each Batch Header is followed by available hate crime incident data. All data records following the Batch Header belong to the ORI of the Batch Header. The Batch Header record can be followed immediately by another Batch Header, which means there were no incident data for the UCR ORI.

Each incident record, identified as Hate Crime Record Type of "IR," has an ORI and Incident Number that together make an incident unique from all others. There may be hate crime incidents following the Batch Header that have a different ORI, but these should be considered part of the Batch Header in which they follow. Although positions 1-7 of the ORI will be identical in such instances, positions 8-9 can be different from the Batch Header's ORI in the same positions. Again, all data records following a Batch Header belong to the ORI of the Batch Header.

BATCH HEADER

This Record Type provides descriptive information about the ORI such as population, judicial district, etc.,. The presence of this record indicates (1) the beginning of a different ORI and (2) that no more hate crime incident data exists for the previous Batch Header (assuming it's not the first record on the magnetic media).

<u>LEVEL</u>	<u>DESCRIPTION</u>
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BH	BATCH HEADER
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As stated above, this record identifies certain attributes about the UCR ORI. It will always be the first record and will be followed by any hate crime incident reports.

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INCIDENT REPORT

This Record Type provides descriptive information about each hate crime incident which was reported. It contains information such as offenses, biases, etc.,. Each incident record holds all offenses which occurred in the incident.

<u>LEVEL</u>	<u>DESCRIPTION</u>
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IR	INCIDENT REPORT
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As stated above, this record contains certain attributes about the hate crime incident. All incidents for an ORI will be grouped together following the BH record for that ORI.

2. SEGMENT LEVELS

INTRODUCTION

The displacements shown in "Record Position" are relative to 1; that is, the first character following any 4-byte record descriptor word (RDW) is shown in position one. If the data requested is in variable-length format and the RDW is presented to the application program as part of the record, add "4" to each displacement for the actual position on the physical data record.

VARIABLE-LENGTH SEGMENTS

Each Segment Level has its own length and will be the length shown in the last "Record Position" displacement for that Segment Level ("BH" is 282 and "IR" is 221). Add "4" bytes to account for the physical presence of the Record Descriptor Word (RDW) when working with the variable length file.

FIXED-LENGTH SEGMENTS

Each Fixed Segment Level's length is 282 bytes and will be padded with trailing blanks as necessary. The longest variable-length Segment Level is the Batch Header Segment which is 286 characters (282 characters plus the 4 character RDW) while the Incident Record is only 225 characters (221 characters plus the 4 character RDW). On the fixed length file all records will be 282 bytes with the "IR" records having an extra 61 bytes of trailing spaces (221 bytes + 61 bytes = 282 bytes).
